Sheena had been admitted to the local childcare institution at the age of 13 following a family crisis. The sudden change from living with her parents and younger sister to living in an institution led to emotional distress and the teenager was not able to adjust to her changed circumstances. She was then referred to a mental health consultant, and following intense counseling and coaching by Miracle Foundation India, she slowly recovered and began to improve her spoken English and writing skills as well. Today Sheena is studying to be a multi-lab technician. She is a brilliant student and is proactive in all her academic and co-curricular activities. But Sheena missed her mother and sister. The Institution could not replace the love of her family.

### **Child Protection Law**

Child protection laws in India are framed in line with constitutional provisions for safeguarding child rights. More than 250 statutes in India, passed by the Union and State Governments, deal with children. Article 21-A guarantees the right to free and compulsory elementary education for all children in the age group 6-14 years. Article 24 (a) secures the right to be protected from any hazardous employment until 14 years. In addition to these child protection laws, we have several criminal laws which give protection to children.
